## Are You Using a Recalled Product?

Below is a list of recalled products posted by the US Consumer Product Safety Commission between May 19 and 28, 2015. **Nantucket Distributing recalls mason jar night light due to burn hazard** - The plastic around the base of the light bulb can melt, posing a burn hazard.



**Hewitt recalls marine winches due to injury hazard** - The top and bottom roller chains in the winch can break, causing the winch and marine lift to fail.



**Kenmore Elite ranges recalled by Electrolux due to laceration hazard; sold exclusively at Sears** - The stainless steel trim below the range control panel can have a sharp edge, posing a laceration hazard to consumers.



**Precision Trading recalls espresso makers due to risk of burns** - The cap at the top of the unit can crack and allow steam to escape, posing a risk of burns to the consumer. In addition, the cap can pop off unexpectedly as a result of pressure buildup.

**Kaldi's Coffee Roasting recalls cup sleeves due to fire hazard** - The cup sleeves can ignite, if microwaved.
