#ElectricalSafetyMonth

In May, electric cooperatives across the country promote safety awareness to coincide with National Electrical Safety Month. Every year, thousands of accidents occur due to shock hazards, and ECI REC, a not-for-profit electric utility, is committed to educating the public about potential electrical dangers in the home.

In 2016, 475,500 structure fires (including residential fires) were reported in the U.S., causing 2,950 deaths, 12,775 injuries, and \$7.9 billion in property damage. According to the National Fire Protection Association, a residential fire was reported every 90 seconds.

Many home fires occur when electrical equipment is outdated or improperly used. "It is critical that the public understands their homes' electrical systems and the safety concerns associated with the latest residential technologies before bringing them into their homes," explained CEO Steve Marlow. "With newer technologies, such as solar panels, electric vehicles, and more electrical gadgets in the home, people need to ensure they have an electrical system that's compatible with the increased load."

To raise awareness of the importance of electrical safety, ECI REC will share a series of safety tips on our Facebook page during May.

Through electrical safety awareness and education, we can all play a part in preventing electrical hazards and injuries in the future. Together, let's plug into safety this May!

Smart Meter Installation Update

Installation of approximately 1,300 smart meters on approximately 1,100 member accounts in the Lindahl and Shellsburg substation areas was completed in mid-April. By the end of April, 582 members within the BECCA substation area also received their new smart meters. The next postcard mailing will go to members in the Karr and Harrison substation areas. These 850+ meter change-outs are slated to be completed within the month of May.

REMEMBER to please keep your meter area(s) clear and accessible so Chapman Metering technicians can easily access it.
