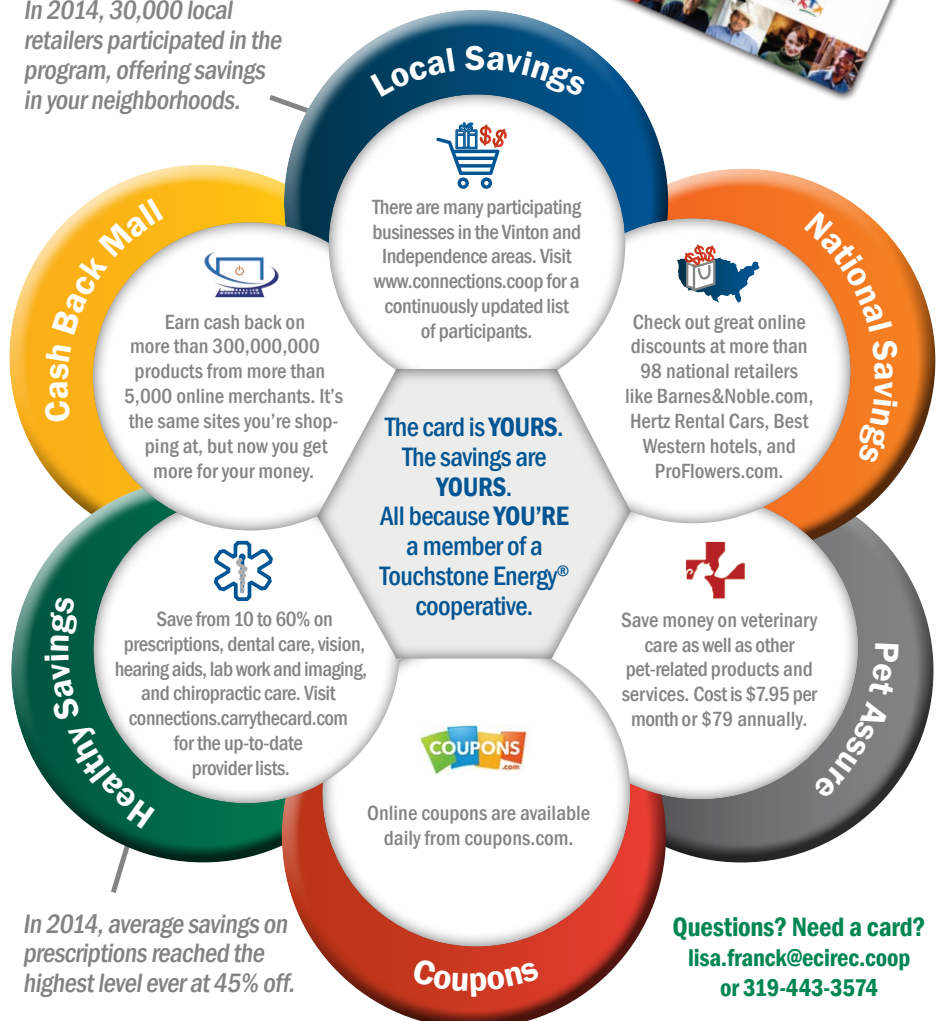

Budget Billing Levels Monthly Payments for Members

ECI REC offers budget billing to help members anticipate monthly costs and make financial planning easier. We calculate your monthly payment based on your 12-month usage history. Accounts are periodically reviewed to ensure that payments match actual usage so you do not face a large debit or credit at the end of the year.
