### Philips Recalls Halogen Bulbs Due to

**Laceration and Burn Hazards** – The lens of the bulb can shatter in the lamp or the lens can fall and shatter, posing a laceration and burn hazard. This recall involves Philips 60W PAR 16 120V halogen bulbs manufactured from November 2013 to March 2015.

### Technical Consumer Products Recalls Connected Brand

**Downlights Due to Electrical Shock Hazard** – The internal wiring in the LED downlights can contact the downlight's metal trim, posing a shock hazard to consumers.

This recall involves Connected by TCP 5-inch and 6-inch LED Downlight retrofits for recessed cans.
