

It is important for members to understand ECI REC's terms and conditions BEFORE they sign a contract for a renewable energy source. There are legal requirements, member responsibilities, an interconnection application, and an agreement ECI REC will need prior to the installation of your renewable energy equipment.

Please contact our Member Service Department if you're planning to invest in a renewable energy source. Resources are also located under the Manage Energy section of ecirec.coop.

ECI REC may have additional technical requirements to ensure:

- » The safety of Cooperative personnel or their agents
- » The prevention of negative effects on the quality and reliability of service to other members of the Cooperative
- » The protection of Cooperative facilities from damage, failure, or inefficient operation
- » Compliance with prudent electric utility practice

Start the New Year Right: Budget Billing Levels Monthly Payments for Members

ECI REC offers budget billing to make financial planning easier and help members anticipate monthly costs. We calculate your monthly payment based on your 12-month usage history. Accounts are periodically reviewed to ensure payments match actual usage, so you do not face a large debit or credit at the end of the year.

Note: Budget billing only applies for members who have an ECI REC usage history of less than 3,000 kWh.



Notify Landlord Before Disconnect

The Notify Landlord Before Disconnect program is available if you own rental property in ECI REC's service area that receives electricity from the Cooperative. You will be notified prior to a meter disconnect while you are renting out the property, which can be helpful if your tenant contacts ECI REC to disconnect the meter when they are moving out. Or, a renter may have late bill payments that could result in meter disconnection. In certain situations and weather conditions, the owner may want to avoid the disconnect.
