

Board of Directors Releases 2022 Service Charges and Fees

After careful review and consideration, the ECI REC Board of Directors determined an increase in some of the Cooperative's electric service charges and fees was necessary. The following fees will be effective for member-owners on June 1, 2022.

- » **Disconnect Member-Owned Security Light:** \$100.00 (unchanged)
- » **Disconnect Power (non-remote):** \$150.00
- » **Locate, Member-Owned Underground Fault:** \$107.00* (unchanged)
- » **Locate, Member-Owned Underground:** \$107.00* (unchanged)
- » **Outage Service Call, after hours:** \$160.50* (unchanged)
- » **Outage Service Call, regular business hours:** \$107.00* (unchanged)
- » **Reconnect (non-remote), after hours:** \$321.00*
- » **Reconnect (non-remote), regular business hours:** \$160.50*
- » **Test Meter:** \$26.75* (unchanged)
- » **Returned Check:** \$30.00 (unchanged)
- » **Non-Payment Posting:** \$150.00
- » **Non-Payment Disconnect (remote):** \$50.00
- » **Non-Payment Reconnect (remote), after hours:** \$80.25*
- » **Non-Payment Reconnect (remote), regular business hours:** \$53.50*

HOW DO I VOTE?

On May 16, ballots will be mailed and online voting will open. All votes—online and mail-in—MUST be received by June 13.

- 1 MAIL** - A ballot was mailed to every member with a self-addressed and stamped return envelope.*
- 2 SMART HUB** - Log in to SmartHub at <https://ecirec.smarthub.coop> and click VOTE NOW. Please note: SmartHub voting must be done in a web browser, not the SmartHub mobile app.
- 3 ONLINE** - Click the blue VOTE NOW button located on the home page at www.ecirec.coop. Enter your voter number and election passcode, which were listed at the bottom of your mailed ballot. Follow online voting instructions.

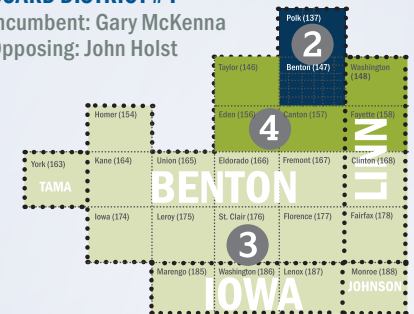

DOES YOUR HOME NEED A CHECKUP?

If your home was last inspected:

- 40 or more years ago, an inspection is overdue.
- 10 to 40 years ago, an inspection is advised.
- Less than 10 years ago, an inspection should not be necessary unless there are issues.

Regardless of when your home was last checked, consult a qualified electrician/licensed contractor if you notice symptoms of a potential hazard, such as dim/flickering lights, unusual sounds, a frequent need to reset fuses or breakers, overheating, odors, loose plugs, damaged insulation on wires, or conditions that cause electrical shocks.
